

Directions To the State Street Parking Deck on The Georgia Tech Campus:

If you're heading northbound (coming from the south, e.g. from the airport):

1. Stay on I-75 / I-85 (North) toward Atlanta.
2. Take Exit 250 (10th Street / 14th Street / Georgia Tech).
3. At the traffic light, turn left onto 10th Street.
4. Continue west on 10th Street for a few blocks until you reach State Street.
5. Turn left onto State Street (entering the campus).
6. The entrance to the W23 / Area 5 Parking Deck (Visitor's Parking) will be on your left

If you're heading southbound (coming from north of campus):

1. Travel on I-75 / I-85 (South) toward downtown / the connector.
2. Exit at 10th / 14th Street (same Exit 250).
3. At the bottom of the ramp / traffic light, turn right onto 10th Street.
4. Proceed west on 10th Street until you get to State Street.
5. Turn left onto State Street
6. Turn left into W23 / Area 5 Deck when you see the entry.

Notes & Tips

- The W23 / Area 5 deck is also referred to as Visitor Parking / Area 5 and is located at the corner of State Street and 10th Street.
- Once parked, exit the deck toward Atlantic Drive to walk to the Klaus Advanced Computing Building

Walking Directions from the State Street Parking Deck to the Klaus Advanced Computing Building

1. Exit the State Street Deck toward Ferst Drive / State Street.
2. Walk east along Ferst Drive heading toward Atlantic Drive.
3. When you reach Atlantic Drive, turn right (heading south) on Atlantic Drive.
4. Walk south past the College of Computing Building on your left.
5. Continue walking through the courtyard and then through the breezeway and down the steps between the College of Computing (CoC) Building and the Microelectronics Research Building.
6. You'll arrive at KACB (Klaus Advanced Computing Building) where you will see signage for the 2025 ICPC Southeast Regional Competition
